MEMORANDUM FOR ALL SEVENTH AIR FORCE PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Alcohol Policy

1. This policy applies to all Air Force personnel assigned or attached permanently, on temporary duty, or on rotational duty, to Seventh Air Force (7 AF) units or organizations supported by 7 AF units, including tenant and geographically separated units. This policy also applies to the following when on an Air Force installation in Korea: Department of Defense (DoD) civilians, DoD-invited contractors/technical representatives, family members of military personnel, DoD civilians, and DoD contractors, and visiting guests. This policy does not apply to individuals engaged in official law enforcement activities.
2. Only those persons in paragraph 1 above who have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years old may purchase, possess or consume alcoholic beverages.
3. No one subject to this order may give, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages to any person who has not attained the age of twenty-one (21) years old. Anyone giving, selling or distributing alcoholic beverages must verify the recipient's or purchaser's age with a government-issued photo identification card (e.g. common access card, dependent identification card, driver's license, passport, family identification and privilege card, etc.).
4. "Alcoholic beverage" is defined as potable beverages containing any amount of ethyl alcohol. This includes, but is not limited to, beer, wine, wine coolers, spirits and liquors.
5. Reference: Air Force Instruction 34-219, Alcoholic Beverage Program (4 Feb 15).
6. **This is a punitive policy. Airmen who fail to comply with the provisions of this order are subject to punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), as well as adverse administrative action authorized by applicable laws and regulations.** Depending on the circumstances, civilians identified in paragraph 1 who violate this policy are subject to administrative actions. Commanders will ensure all personnel under their command are aware of, and fully understand, the requirements of this alcohol policy.
